The completed research has shown that there is an urgent need to develop transport systems that make transport less fragile and more resilient to future challenges.

New Monetary Policy Tools for Emerging Market and Developing Economies

The COVID-19 pandemic spurred Emerging Markets and Developing Economies' (EMDE) central banks to introduce a wide array of unconventional monetary policy actions. These included asset purchases, typically of sovereign debt, to improve bond market liquidity and ease market stresses. These tools appeared effective in improving market functioning and are likely to remain a key component of the toolkit of EMDE central banks.
