SAVE THE DATE: Sudan Ebolavirus Candidate Vaccines - What additional research should be conducted to advance the evaluation of these vaccines?

On 20 September 2022, Uganda declared an outbreak of Sudan ebolavirus, after the confirmation of a case in Mubende district in the central part of the country. Responding to this outbreak, the WHO convened emergency meetings to prioritize candidate vaccines. In coordination with Ugandan researchers, health authorities, and regulators, a ring vaccination protocol was developed and locally approved. Currently, Makerere University is ready to conduct a trial if new cases are confirmed and doses of the three candidate vaccines are currently available.
