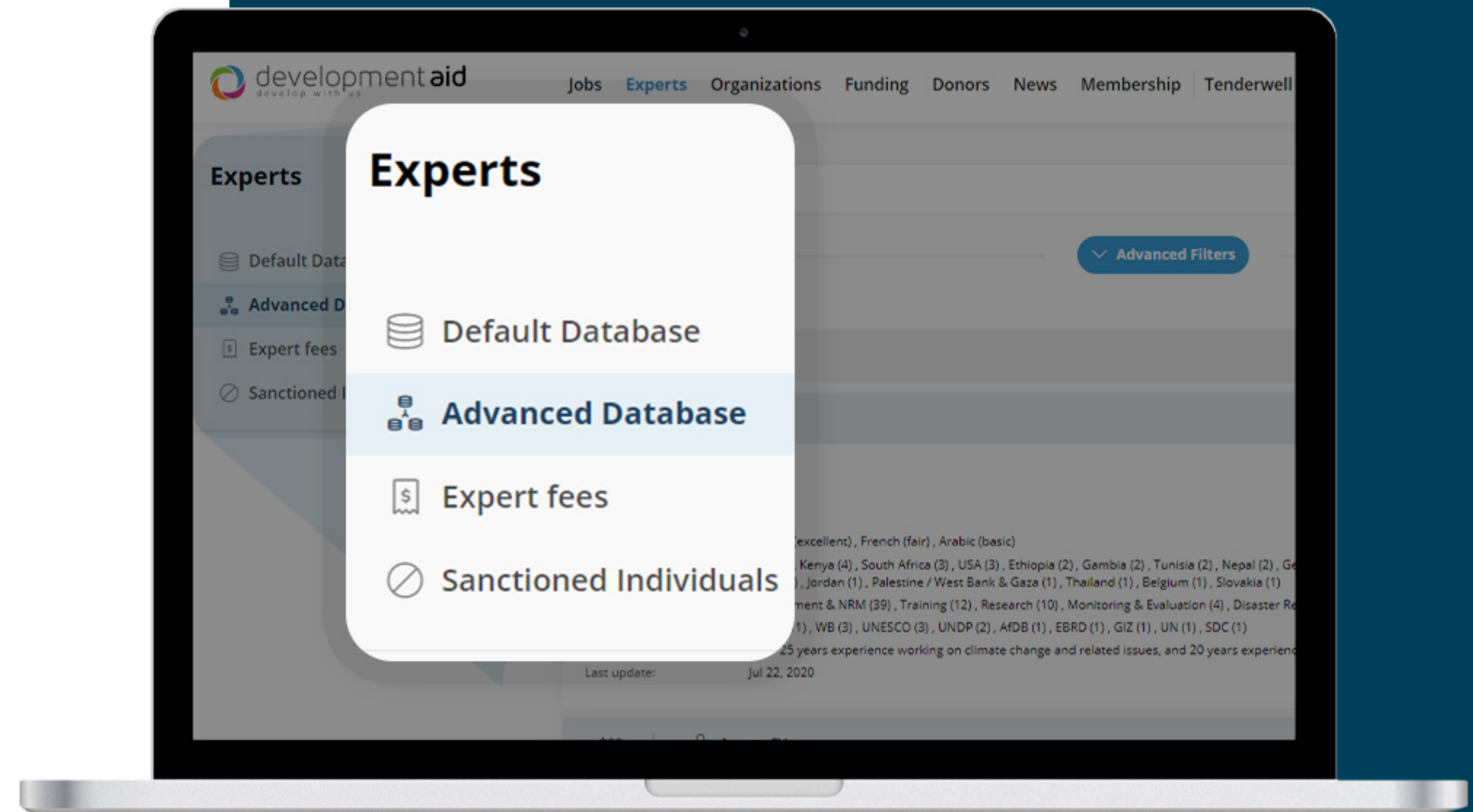

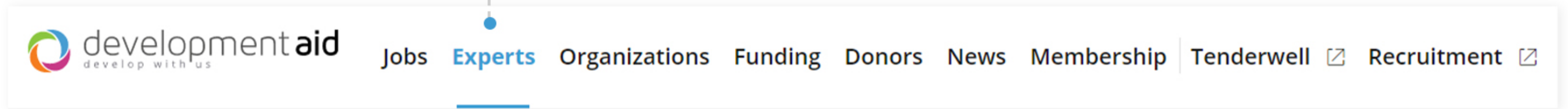

## The second way to view an expert's profile is the full CV view.

An expert's CV can easily be viewed in any of five standard formats (World Bank, AfDB, ADB, EuropeAid, and DevelopmentAid) to ensure that a CV is presented in the manner most amenable to the user.
